



Exercise Title: **Anthropological participatory tools in the community work** regarding the culture of remembrance, making an exhibition

Recommended group size/type: 3-20

Recommended time: 2 hours minimum up to months

Preparation time: 2 hours

AIMS and objectives (general, concrete) *To share and learn about cultural heritage or different people through objects and activities. Collect information, learn to make an exhibition. Our partners gained work experience in Finland and improved in Finnish language and cultural knowledge. Many got a place to study or even a work after the project.
